2025 Annual Report

Message from the DCCF Board:

In July 2016, a group of caring people gathered to create a community foundation for our county. Since then, 37 nonprofits have become partners, and today the Doniphan County Community Foundation (DCCF) funds have total assets of more than \$3,022,000. DCCF exists to help nonprofits connect with area people who care deeply about their causes.

Our nonprofits continued to prosper during 2025, and DCCF funds worked to make Doniphan County a better place to live. Youth programs were supported, children received books, and animals were cared for. Murals were painted, building projects were started and completed, and parks and main streets were beautified. Healthcare was emphasized, scholarships were awarded, and many more fund activities, too numerous to mention, were also in process.

Our 2025 Give Where You Live (GWYL) Day proved to be another resounding success and a year of remarkable growth. Thanks are due to many people. First of all, DCCF wants to thank the match money providers and the local donors who contributed more than \$228,000.00 to the 38 participating funds through 400 gifts. Of that total, \$128,940.24 came from donations and \$99,999.98 from match funds. This reflects a significant increase from 2024, when \$104,048.52 in donations and \$95,000.00 in match funds generated over \$199,000.00 for 32 funds through 319 gifts. (We have grown: our first GWYL Day in 2018 raised \$38,000.)

The 2025 DCCF board continues to witness strong energy surrounding GWYL Day, with an excitement to give and support local nonprofits. The generosity of both local donors and match providers continues to grow each year, with gifts both large and small contributing to the success and momentum of this event. The DCCF Board is excited to build on this progress as we begin a new year, continuing to support our nonprofits and the meaningful projects that make Doniphan County a great place to live, love, work, and play.

Composed of volunteers from across the county, the DCCF board remains inspired by the philanthropic spirit we see in the generosity of our donors. We know good projects are being planned, and we are committed to helping our funds reach their goals.
